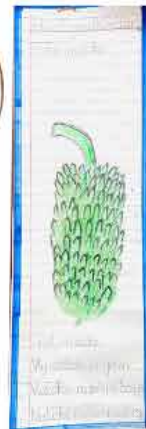


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We choose our moves carefully in chess as in life.
